White parking ticket machines for Nieuwpoort

Hectronic's Belgian sales partner Rauwers has clinched a deal for the Belgian city of Nieuwpoort. A total of 139 white Citea parking ticket machines with solar panels have been installed in Nieuwpoort. The machines are able to take coin payments, they feature a 12 button key pad and they are connected to the web-based CityLine management software. The Flemish town of Nieuwpoort on the Belgian coast is situated directly on the estuary of the River Yser to the North Sea. The colours white and blue are typical for this coastal region. The identification and reference to the colour white is very significant on the coast. This explains why Nieuwpoort

chose to have white parking ticket machines. Rauwers benefits from a very good market share in this region, as drivers already know the Hectronic parking ticket machines from the nearby towns of Koksijde and DePanne. This deal was a great success and it opens the way to other towns and cities in Belgium.



HecFleets for the Polish army



In cooperation with the Polish branch of Hectronic, a total of 12 HecFleet fuel terminals were installed for the Polish army. At the same time, seven work stations were also equipped with the filling station management software HecPoll including Web Client function.

Both the terminals and the software come with the Polish language installed. Now up to 100,000 Mifare tags can be administered and clients can be controlled thanks to the assignment of client creation and management privileges. The final acceptance of the complete system was carried out in accordance with the NATO AQAP 2131 process. The client praised the high quality of the product and the reliability and user-friendliness of the software and fuel terminal in particular.

EFFIA chooses Hectronic parking system

Hectronic France was selected by the French company EFFIA to equip the towns of Lens in northern France and Villiers sur Marne in the eastern suburbs of Paris with a parking system solution.

EFFIA Stationnement is a subsidiary of EFFIA and was founded in 1998 as part of the SNCF/KEOLIS Group. Today, with a total of 155,000 parking areas, these are now the second biggest group in France in the area of parking. EFFIA Stationnement was chosen by the town of Lens and commune of Villiers sur Marne to look after their parking space management. As a result, Hectronic France was commissioned by EFFIA Stationnement with the supply

and installation of 86 Citea parking ticket machines in Lens and 55 Citea parking ticket machines in Villiers sur Marne. These parking ticket machines also accept payment by credit card. In addition, all parking ticket machines in Lens are controlled by the Hectronic software CityLine.

The „Stade de France“ is situated in Saint-Denis, a northern suburb of Paris, and is France's largest stadium. Football matches, rugby matches and other events, such as concerts, take place in this stadium.

The French subsidiary of Hectronic has recently won a tender from the Plaine Commune for the supply and installation of parking ticket machines.

The Plaine Commune consists of 8 communes in the north-eastern suburbs of Paris, including the commune of Saint-Denis. Over the next four years, at least 200 Citea parking ticket machines fitted with EMV card readers and pinpads will be supplied. The supply of machines already started this year in the communes of La Courneuve and Saint-Denis.

First congress for independent petrol station dealers in Vienna

Hectronic's subsidiary EDV-SOS GmbH takes part in the first congress for independent petrol station dealers held in Vienna.

From 19 to 20 November, the first congress for independent petrol station dealers was held at the NOVOMATIC FORUM in Vienna, where Hectronic's subsidiary EDV-SOS GmbH was presenting with an exhibition stand. Eighty-four companies were represented at this congress and the feedback after the event was extremely positive.

A large interest was seen in the area of AVR technology, which will also play a major role in future. EDV-SOS can reflect on a successful event and it was able to make and strengthen many interesting contacts.
